Visit to Bangladesh

The Secretary-General of Developing Eight Organization for Economic Cooperation (D-8), H.E Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam, while on his maiden visit to Bangladesh, met with the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Sheikh Hasina, at the Ganabhaban in Dhaka on Wednesday, 23 February, 2022.

Both the Prime Minister and the D-8 Secretary General reiterated the need

for materializing the D-8 Preferential Trade Agreement to harness the immense economic potential for promoting trade among the Member States. The Prime Minister expressed the readiness of her government to make available to Member States exclusive facilities and land in Banladesh's 'Special Economic Zones' and invited Member States to latch on this oppor tu nity to further enhance economic cooperation.

Ambassador Imam had briefed the Prime Minister, who is also the current Chair of D-8, on the activities and initiatives of the organization, while highlighting the new projects and initiatives undertaken by D-8.

The Secretary General expressed his resolve to further promote the visibility of the organization through enhancing project-based cooperation among Member States, so that the benefits of such cooperation would reach the grassroots level.




COURTESY VISITS AND EXTERNAL RELATIONS


The Secretary General of the Ambassador Isiaka Developing Eight Organization for Economic courtesy call on the Chief Cooperation (D8),



Seventh D-8 Agriculture Ministerial Meeting

The People's Republic of Bangladesh hosted the 7th D-8 Ministerial Meeting on Agriculture and Food Security virtually from 12-13 January 2022, under the theme: "Promotion of Climate Smart Agriculture: Key issues for D-8 Member States".

The Meeting discussed comprehensively on exploring opportunities for sustainable Agricultural Development and Promoting Climate Smart Agriculture (CSA) in D-8 Member States.

In this regard, the People's Republic of Bangladesh proposed the project "Scaling up Climate Smart Agriculture (SCSA)" for D-8 Member Countries. The project is aimed at capacitating farmers and the rural communities in D-8 countries to improve their agricultural production systems towards food and nutrition security, scaling up crop intensification, increased farm income and livelihood improvement through coping, adapting and mitigating unpredictable climate impacts.

D-8 Technology Transfer And Exchange Network (D-8 TTEN)

Technology Investment Meeting, Tim 2022 Held

The 4th Technology Investment Meeting (TIM 2022) was organized in a hybrid format (in-person and virtual attendance) by the D-8 Organization for Economic Cooperation, the D-8 Technology Transfer and Exchange Network (D-8 TTEN) Secretariat and Pardis Technology Park in Tehran, Iran, from 21-22 February, 2022. The Meeting was honored to host the D-8 Secretary-General, Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam through live broadcast.

The event was attended by participants drawn from D-8 Member Countries, representatives of local and foreign companies and investors from

different parts of the world.

Technology investment is one of the main areas through which Member States could derive maximum benefits in economic cooperation. TIM 2022 offered participants from D-8 countries platform to create synergy between stakeholders operating in the IT sector.

Activities of TIM 2022 included speeches, panel discussions, B2B

meetings. Highlights of the event were:

- i. Establishment of network D-8 VC investors to improve longterm cooperation in the field of technological investment.
- ii. Establishment of D-8 CO-Fund and forming of Innovation Co-Fund Working Group.

At the end of the event, it was announced that TIM 2023 will be held at the Pardis Technology Park in Iran from 27-28 February, 2023.

- Facilitate mutual investment opportunities for joint SMEs in multi-national innovation ecosystems.

The cooperation includes joint funding of transnational cooperative research, development and innovation projects. The joint funding is organized based on national/regional funding programs with both joint evaluation and investment procedure. The cooperation also applies to any related activities between members, especially promotion of the initiative and the co-organization of rotating partnering events.



Inaugural Meeting of D-8 Innovation Co-fund Initiative (D-8 COFI Working Group)

The inaugural meeting held on February 22, 2022 on the sideline of 4th Technology Investment Meeting. The D-8 TTEN Secretariat hosted the meeting where delegates from Egypt, Iran, Malaysia, Nigeria, Pakistan and Turkey attended the meeting virtually and in-person.

D-8 Innovation Co-Fund Initiative is a multilateral cooperative funding platform established to

enable participants to:

- Share the national science, technology & industrial policies, and research activities in the member countries and create joint collaborations for benefit of member states;
- Mobilize multi-national and transdisciplinary collaborative STLactions:
- Strengthen the interactions of





In line with the Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations, the Developing-8 has focused its attention on improving the health and livelihoods of its citizens through the Health and Social Protection Programme (D-8 HSP), which

supports governments of Member countries to accelerate progress towards reduction of poverty, hunger, improvement of health and livelihoods. These interventions of the D-8 directly contribute to accelerating the attainment of SDGs 1, 2 & 3.

One of D-8 HSP's key priorities is innovative resource mobilization in accordance with

her strategic plan 2021-2025, under the thematic area of innovative financing to support D-8 countries in identifying innovative financing strategies to complement government funding for health and social protection interventions. In Nigeria, the D-8 HSP's consultation on the pooling of Zakat to address poverty, hunger and improve health and wellbeing gained momentum following series of engagements with the Nigeria Country Office of the United Nations High Commission on Refugees (UNHCR). D-8 HSP has received endorsement of the UNHCR with regard to pioneering work in mobilizing zakat and waqf for displaced people.

Diverse Islamic groups, under the umbrella of Association of Zakat and Waqf Organizations in Nigeria (AZAWON), have been engaged by D-8 HSP and are keen to see how learning from the conventional Zakat collection and payment in Nigeria, the D-8 HSP would generate digital tools, build mobilization capacities and expand the scope to directly reduce poverty, hunger and help Nigeria in reducing health inequalities and burden of outof-pocket expenses for health through Zakat.

D-8 Network of Pioneers on Research and Innovation (D-8 NPRI)
