STATUTORY MEETINGS

THE 47TH SESSION OF THE D-8 COMMISSION, DHAKA, BANGLADESH, 22-23 OCTOBER 2023



Bangladesh, as the current D-8 Chair, hosted the 47th Session of the D-8 Commission, the organization's executive body, in Dhaka from 22 – 23 October 2023. The D-8 Commissioners and Heads of Delegation from the D-8 Member States and the D-8 Secretary-General attended the Session.

During the meeting, Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam, the D-8 Secretary-General, presented the D-8 progress report since the previous 46th Session of the D-8 Commission held in Istanbul from 15 – 16 February 2023. He also presented new initiatives to elevate the D-8 organization to new heights. Subsequently, the Commission, the D-8's executive branch, discussed administrative and policy agendas for the Organization's activities.

Madame Wahida Ahmed, the Director General of the International Organization of the Bangladesh Ministry of Foreign Affairs, who is also the D-8 Commissioner of Bangladesh, chaired the two-day meeting, while Ambassador Masud Bin Momen, the Foreign Secretary of the Bangladeshi Ministry of Foreign Affairs, delivered opening remarks.



During the meeting, the Commission deliberated on issues related to the six key priority areas of cooperation of the D-8: Trade, Agriculture and Food Security, Industrial Cooperation, Energy, Transportation, and Tourism. In addition to that, they also discussed the possibility of mainstreaming Climate Change, Disaster Management, and economic empowerment of women in their member states.

The Commission also discussed administrative matters, including the programs and activities undertaken in the outgoing year. Among the decisions of the 47th Session was the recommendation for the D-8 to streamline the issue of climate change and women's economic empowerment in the agenda of the D8 Organization. It was also agreed that priority should be placed on the implementation of tangible programs and activities that would contribute to the further development of the Organization.

EDITION IV 2023 (OCTOBER-DECEMBER)



The Commissioners unanimously agreed to expedite action on implementing the bloc's D8 Preferential Trade Agreement (PTA), signed in 2006—the practical implementation of the Agreement would help to drive other D-8 pillars of cooperation.

The D-8 Supports the Palestinian People

During its 47th Session, the D-8 Commission also issued a statement of solidarity and support for the Palestinian people. The statement, titled: "Joint Communique of the D-8 Commission on the Situation in Palestine', called upon the D-8 Member States to, as a matter of emergency, provide humanitarian assistance, including collaborating with relevant international organizations, such as the United Nations Relief and Work Agency for Palestine Refugees in The Near East (UNRWA).

The D-8 also expressed condolences to the Palestinian people for the massive loss of lives and sufferings that were caused by the Israeli military aggression. It further called for immediate cessation of hostilities and crimes against humanity in the Gaza Strip, Palestine.

According to the D-8 Secretary-General, Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam, the Joint Communique was issued within the framework of humanitarian support upon the overwhelming grave concern over the escalation of aggression against the people of Palestine.

"It is the least we can do to support the Palestinian people under these grave circumstances of blatant humanitarian law violations," Ambassador Imam added.



The Joint Communique

We, the Commissioners of the Developing-8 Organization for Economic Cooperation and the Heads of Delegations from the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the Arab Republic of Egypt, the Republic of Indonesia, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Malaysia, the Federal Republic of Nigeria, the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Republic of Türkiye, gathering for our 47th Session in Dhaka, Bangladesh, on 22-23 October 2023, express our profound condolences to the Palestinian people for the massive loss of lives and suffering that are caused by the ongoing besiege and bombardment of Gaza, Palestine. We pray that Allah, the Almighty, grants the Palestinians consolation and strength in their just struggle to establish a sovereign, independent and viable State of Palestine.

We are deeply concerned over the blatant violation of human rights and international humanitarian law by the Israeli military aggression in Palestine that caused immense sufferings for the Palestinians, mostly women and children. We call for immediate cessation of hostilities and stopping the crimes against humanity in the Gaza Strip, Palestine.

We call for opening a humanitarian corridor inside Gaza to ensure humanitarian assistance and the provision of basic human needs to all Palestinians.

We call upon all member states to provide humanitarian assistance immediately, including collaborating with relevant international organizations, such as the United Nations Relief and Work Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA).

BANGLADESH HOSTED "THE YOUNG LEADERSHIP PROGRAM FOR DIPLOMATS FROM THE D-8 MEMBER STATES" IN DHAKA ON 15 – 21 OCTOBER 2023



Bangladesh organized a week-long Young Leadership Program for Diplomats from the Developing-8 Organization's Member States at its Foreign Services Academy in Dhaka on 15-21 October 2023.

Diplomats from the D-8 Member States participated in the Program, which allowed them to gain more profound knowledge and broaden their network with fellow diplomats from the D-8 Member States.





After completing the program, the Certificate Award Ceremony was organized on 21 October 2023. Commissioners, Members of the Delegation of the D-8 Member States, and the D-8 Secretary-General, who were in Dhaka for the 47th Session of the D-8, attended the Ceremony.

In his remarks at the program's closing ceremony, the D-8 Secretary-General underscored the program's importance in harnessing stronger collaboration and mutual understanding among the D-8 Member States. He appreciated Member States who have organized similar programs and appealed to other Member States to take a cue.

D-8 SG'S OFFICIAL VISITS TO THE MEMBER STATES

OFFICIAL VISIT TO INDONESIA

To forge a more substantial and coherent coordination with the member states to achieve the D-8 objectives, Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam, the D-8 Secretary-General, paid an official visit to Indonesia from 18 to 24 November 2023. Mr. Ahmar Ismail, Director for Administrative and Sectoral Affairs, and Mr. Punjul S. Nugraha, Director for Economy and External Affairs of the D-8 Secretariat, accompanied the D-8 Secretary-General.

The visit afforded the D-8 SG valuable opportunities to present the status update on the organization to the relevant Ministries in Indonesia. The SG also secured a commitment from the line agencies to organize some activities for 2024 and 2025. The D-8 SG also used the opportunity to meet with his counterpart at the ASEAN Secretariat in Jakarta.

The summary of the D-8 Secretary-General's official visit to Indonesia, in chronological order, is as follows:





The D-8 SG had a fruitful meeting with H.E. Sandiaga Salahuddin Uno, the Minister of Tourism and Creative Economy of Indonesia, accompanied by senior officials from the Ministry of Tourism and Creative Economy of Indonesia, in Jakarta on 20 November 2023.

The D-8 SG commended Indonesia's stellar performance in tourism, particularly the quick revival of the sector in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic. He, however, hoped Indonesia could share her experiences through collaboration with other member states.

The meeting also discussed tangible programs to be implemented in 2024 and subsequent years to advance tourism cooperation within the D-8 framework.

THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE MINISTRY OF COOPERATIVES AND SMES OF INDONESIA

The D-8 SG met with the senior management of the Ministry of Cooperatives and Small and Medium Enterprises of the Republic of Indonesia, led by Mr. Arif Rahman Hakim, the Secretary General/Permanent Secretary of the Ministry, in Jakarta on 20 November 2023.

The meeting discussed programs and activities to strengthen collaboration in SME development within the D-8 framework. The two sides identified and agreed on programs to be organized in 2024, including revisiting the subsisting MoU on SME Governmental Bodies.



THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE VICE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF INDONESIA

The D-8 SG met with H.E. Pahala Nugraha Mansury, the Vice Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, in Jakarta on 20 November 2023. H.E. Ambassador Tri Tharyat, the Director General for Multilateral Cooperation/D-8 Commissioner of Indonesia, and officials from the D-8 desk of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs were also in attendance.

The D-8 SG commended Indonesia's support in advancing the sectoral cooperation of his organization.





The two dignitaries discussed the way forward for the D-8 Organization, including the need to focus on activities with tangible results, such as the immediate implementation of the D-8 Preferential Trade Agreement (D-8 PTA) to strengthen the bloc's intratrade relations.

The D8-SG also commended Indonesia's relentless support for the State of Palestine.

THE D-8 SG ATTENDED A WORKING DINNER HOSTED BY D-8 COMMISSIONER OF INDONESIA

The D-8 SG attended an informal working dinner, which H.E. Ambassador Tri Tharyat, Deputy Minister for Multilateral Cooperation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the D-8 Commissioner of Indonesia, hosted in Jakarta on 20 November 2023.

Ms. Penny D. Herasati, Director of the International Organization of Developing Countries International Organizations, Mr. Ary Aprianto, Coordinator for OIC and D-8, and Mr. Pragusdinianto Sumantri, Desk Officer for D-8, were in attendance.





While savoring Indonesia's cuisine, the two dignitaries and their respective entourage exchanged views on the way forward for the D-8 Organization. The D-8 SG reiterated his call for Indonesia's continued support for the work of the D-8 to achieve the goals and objectives set forth by its founding Fathers in 1997.

THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE SENIOR MANAGEMENT OF THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY OF INDONESIA



The D-8 SG met with the senior management of the Ministry of Industry of the Republic of Indonesia, led by Mr. Putu Juli Ardika, Director General for Agro Industry/Permanent Secretary of the Ministry, in Jakarta on 21 November 2023. Other senior officials from the Ministry of Industry were also in attendance.

The meeting discussed the rejuvenation of the D-8 industrial cooperation, which was halted during the Covid-19 pandemic.

The two sides also agreed to revisit the pending hosting by Indonesia of the 7th D-8 Ministerial Meeting on Industrial Cooperation as soon as possible. It was also decided to streamline industrial cooperation to focus on areas that can produce tangible results.

THE D-8 SG MET THE VICE MINISTER FOR TRADE OF INDONESIA

The D-8 SG met with H.E. Dr. Jerry Sambuaga, the Vice Minister for Trade of the Republic of Indonesia, in Jakarta on 21 November 2023. Officers responsible for the D-8 PTA from the Ministry of Trade of Indonesia were also in attendance.

The two dignitaries discussed the way forward for implementing the D-8 PTA. The D-8 Secretary-General noted Indonesia's readiness to implement the PTA, which the latter had formally notified the Secretariat. The meeting also identified programs to be organized to support better implementation of the D-8 PTA, particularly capacity-building programs to be organized in 2024 and 2025.



D-8 SG MET WITH THE VICE CHAIRWOMAN OF KADIN OF INDONESIA



The D-8 SG met with Ms. Shinta W. Kamdani, the Vice Chairwoman of the Indonesia Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KADIN), where both held a productive meeting in Jakarta on 22 November 2023. Relevant officials of the KADIN participated in the meeting.

The meeting discussed innovative ways to reinvigorate partnerships among the business entities in the D-8 under the Association of Chambers of Commerce of the Member States. The two sides shared a common view that the private sector must be enlightened about the D-8 PTA and its benefits. They both agreed to conduct joint activities to raise awareness of the private sector in Indonesia about the PTA.

Several activities were identified that could be organized in collaboration among the Chambers, through the D-8 Chambers of Commerce and Industry (D-8 CCI) and the D-8 Secretariat starting from next year.

D-8 SECRETARY-GENERAL MET WITH THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AND SPORTS OF INDONESIA

The D-8 SG met with H.E. Dito Airotedjo, the Minister for Youth and Sports of the Republic of Indonesia, in Jakarta on 22 November 2023. The senior management of the Ministry of Youth and Sports of the Republic of Indonesia was present at the meeting.

The D-8 SG apprised the Minister about the D-8 efforts to mainstream youth empowerment in achieving its objectives, which the Minister graciously supported.





The D-8 Sec. Gen. also mulled the idea of organizing an annual D-8 Sports Competition among member countries, which Indonesia can host, such as a D-8 badminton tournament in 2024. The Minister welcomed the idea and suggested that his office and the D-8 Secretariat kick-start the preparation in earnest.

THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE HEAD OF THE CENTRE FOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING OF THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF INDONESIA

The D-8 SG met with the management of the Centre of Education and Training (Pusdiklat) of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, led by H.E. Ambassador Mohammad K. Koba, in Jakarta on 22 November 2023. The Director for Senior Diplomatic Training, the Director for Mid-Career Diplomatic Training, and the Coordinator for Institutional Cooperation were also in attendance.

The Meeting explored cooperation on diplomatic training among the D-8 Member States, complemented by joint research, regular consultation among diplomatic training institutions, and exchange of experiences.

The two sides also discussed the possibility of Indonesia organizing diplomatic training for diplomats from the D-8 Member States. The modalities for organizing the training will be determined at a later date.



THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORTATION OF INDONESIA



The D-8 SG met the senior management of the Ministry of Transportation of the Republic of Indonesia, led by Mr. Novie Riyanto R, the Secretary-General/Permanent Secretary of the Ministry, in Jakarta on 23 November 2023.

The two sides discussed programs in the transportation sector to be implemented starting in 2024. However, in their discussion, particular emphasis was given to civil aviation and maritime interconnectivity.

Indonesia is currently chairing the Task Force on Commercial Issues on Civil Aviation and will organize a follow-up activity for the 12th D-8 Directors-General of Civil Aviation meeting, which was held in Bali, Indonesia, in October 2022. The Ministry of Transportation of Indonesia also indicated its readiness to host the meeting on maritime connectivity among the D-8 Member States at a date to be determined.

THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE DEPUTY SECRETARY-GENERAL OF ASEAN FOR POLITICAL SECURITY COMMUNITY

Concluding his official visit to Indonesia, the D-8 SG met with H.E. Ambassador Michael Tene, the Deputy Secretary-General of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN), for ASEAN Political-Security Community (APSC) at the ASEAN Secretariat in Jakarta on 23 November 2023.

The D-8 Secretary-General and ASEAN Deputy SG exchanged views on their respective organizations' activities and priority areas, such as trade, agriculture, ICT, energy, and tourism. They also shared the best practices for managing external relations, including partnerships with other entities and organizations.

The meeting agreed to strengthen institutional cooperation through regular discussion via video conferencing.



OFFICIAL VISIT TO NIGERIA

To further the Secretariat's engagement with Member States, Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam, the D-8 SG, paid an official visit to Nigeria from 18 to 24 December 2023. Mr. Punjul S. Nugraha, Director for Economy and External Relations of the D-8 Secretariat, accompanied the D-8 SG for the visit.

The official visit provided the D-8 SG with opportunities to introduce progress updates of the D-8 to the new Administration in Nigeria, especially relevant Ministers and high-ranking government officials. The D-8 SG also engaged with the media industry in Nigeria to bolster the Organization's efforts to increase its visibility in member states.

The summary of the D-8 SG visit to Nigeria, in chronological order, is as follows:

THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE CEO OF NIPC

The D-8 SG started his official visit to Nigeria by meeting with Ms. Aisha Rimi, the Executive Secretary/CEO of the Nigerian Investment Promotion Commission (NIPC), in Abuja on 18 December 2023.

The two dignitaries discussed investment promotion in the member states, including follow-up programs of the 8th World Investment Forum and the D-8 and UNCTAD collaboration on the reform of international investment agreements held in Abu Dhabi from 16 – 20 October 2023.





The two sides agreed to jointly organize activities in 2024, including the possibility of holding a Conference of the D-8 investment promotion agencies in Nigeria in 2024. The NIPC also expressed readiness to host incoming business/trade missions from other D-8 Member States in 2024.

THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF SMEDAN

In continuation of his official engagement in Abuja during the visit, the D-8 SG met with Mr. Charles O. Odii, the Director General/CEO of the Small and Medium Enterprises Development Agency of Nigeria (SMEDAN) in Abuja, on 18 December 2023.

The two dignitaries, accompanied by their respective delegations, discussed collaboration to support and promote the development of the SME sector in the D-8 Member States. It was agreed that the partnership is crucial, considering that SMEs are the backbone of the economies of the D-8 Member States. The two sides explored potential activities in 2024, including launching the proposed D-8 Center for Small and Medium Enterprises (D-8 SME Center) in Abuja.





The D-8 SG also attended the commissioning of the new Corporate Headquarters of the Small and Medium Enterprises Development Agency of Nigeria (SMEDAN) in Abuja on Wednesday, 20 December 2023.

The new premises of SMEDAN, commissioned by H.E. Kashim Shettima, the Vice President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, are equipped with modern facilities to support SME development, such as garment and furniture-making machinery.

THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE PERMANENT SECRETARY OF THE NIGERIAN MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS

The D-8 SG met with H.E. Ambassador Adamu Ibrahim Lamuwa, the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, in Abuja on 18 December 2023.

The two dignitaries discussed the 47th Session of the D-8 Commission, held in Dhaka, Bangladesh, on 22-23 October 2023. The meeting also cemented Nigeria's support for advancing collaboration in various D-8 priority areas, particularly on energy, development of SMEs, youth, science, technology, and innovation.



THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE MANAGING DIRECTOR OF NBET



The D-8 SG met with Dr. Nnaemeka Ewelukwa, the Managing Director of the Nigerian Bulk Electricity Trading, Plc. (NBET), in Abuja on 19 December 2023.

The two dignitaries discussed how to materialize the proposed D-8 Energy Forum to be hosted in Nigeria in 2024. Given the importance of energy for economic development, they agreed to pursue vigorously the hosting of the proposed Energy Forum in Nigeria by engaging robustly with the relevant stakeholders. They also discussed contemporary energy issues, particularly renewable energy.

Earlier, the D-8 SG also had a brief meeting with Mr. James Sule, OON, NPOM, and the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Science, Technology, and Innovation of Nigeria to discuss collaboration on technological advancement within the D-8 framework.

THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FOOD SECURITY OF NIGERIA

The D-8 SG paid a courtesy call on H.E. Senator Abubakar Kyari, the Honorable Minister of Agriculture and Food Security of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, in Abuja on 20 December 2023.

The Ministry's senior management also attended the meeting, which discussed tangible programs to strengthen D-8 agricultural cooperation. The meeting also discussed the forthcoming 8th Session of the D-8 Ministerial Meeting on Agriculture and Food Security, which Nigeria proposed to host in 2024.



THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE MANAGEMENT OF CHANNELS TV OF NIGERIA



The D-8 SG met with the management of the Channels TV at the Abuja Office. He was received by Mr. Chamberlain Usoh, who is the Station Manager, on Thursday, 21 December 2023.

The two sides discussed mutually beneficial collaboration, mainly to increase the visibility of the D-8 Organization in Nigeria.

During the visit, the D-8 Secretary-General granted an interview to Channels TV session, where he presented further clarification about the vision and mission of the D-8 Organization. The D-8 SG also spoke about the vast potential of his organization's various activities and collaborations to benefit all its stakeholders in member states, including Nigeria.

THE D-8 SG PAID A COURTESY CALL ON THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY, TRADE, AND INVESTMENT OF NIGERIA

The D-8 SG paid a courtesy call on H.E. Dr. Doris Nkiruka Uzoka-Anite MD, CFA, the Honorable Minister of Industry, Trade, and Investment of the Federal Republic of Nigeria in Abuja on 21 December 2023.

The D-8 Secretary-General presented a status update of the D-8 Organization in pursuing its economic objectives, including the impending implementation of the D-8 Preferential Trade Agreement D-8 PTA. The D8 SG underscored the importance of the D8 Trade Ministers Meeting and sought the support of the Minister to attend the subsequent Trade Ministers Meeting when convened by Bangladesh.





The meeting also discussed Nigeria's readiness to complete the required internal procedures to fully implement the D-8 PTA as soon as possible.

The two dignitaries also discussed collaborative programs for SME development.

THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE MINISTER OF YOUTH DEVELOPMENT OF NIGERIA

The D-8 SG paid a courtesy call on H.E. Dr. Jamila Bio Ibrahim, the Honorable Minister of Youth Development of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, in Abuja on 21 December 2023.

The two dignitaries shared common views on the need to mainstream youth development issues, focusing on entrepreneurship, to support economic activities to attain the D-8 economic objectives. The D-8 SG also sought support from the Honorable Minister for the proposed D-8 Youth Council, which will be established in 2024, including the Minister's attendance at the 1st Meeting of the D8 Youth Ministers, which is expected to be held in Bangladesh in 2024.



THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE NIGERIAN TELEVISION AUTHORITY (NTA)



The D-8 SG met with the Nigerian Television Authority (NTA), led by the NTA Director-General, Mr. Salihu Abdulhamid Dembos, in Abuja on Thursday, 21 December 2023.

The two sides discussed the role of the media, particularly the NTA, in promoting the visibility of the D-8 for the benefit of all stakeholders in Member States. During the visit, cooperation among broadcasting stations in the D-8 Member States was also discussed.

D-8 SG MET WITH THE MANAGEMENT OF LOTUS BANK OF NIGERIA

The D-8 SG held a meeting with the senior management of LOTUS Bank, led by Ms. Kafilat Araoye, the Managing Director of the LOTUS Bank, in Lagos, on 22 December 2023.

The two sides discussed potential collaboration in the financial sector that would support the D-8 economic cooperation. The D-8 SG also presented several D-8 initiatives in the financial sector that are in the pipeline. The two sides also explored the possibility of hosting joint activities in 2024 to bolster their collaboration.



THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE TVC COMMUNICATIONS OF NIGERIA



The D-8 SG met with officials of TVC Communications in Lagos on 22 December 2023. The meeting discussed the cooperation to elevate the visibility of the D-8 organization through the TVC's broadcast services.

The two sides also discussed the possibility of TVC Communications covering some D-8 activities, including submitting audio-visual tapes for airing on TVC news. While at the TVC Communications' headquarters, the D-8 SG granted an interview to the TVC Reporter, where he explained his goals and targets as the Chief Scribe of the D-8 Organization.

The meeting was held over dinner and hosted by Chief Oye to discuss how to strengthen the role of the private sector, especially trade, in achieving the D-8's objectives.

The two sides also discussed programs to be organized in 2024, in which NACCIMA will play a significant role, including the proposed D-8 energy forum, the support for SME development, and strengthening the relationship between NACCIMA and the D-8 envoys resident in Nigeria.



THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE VICE-CHANCELLOR OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ILORIN, NIGERIA



The D-8 SG met with Professor Wahab Olasupo Egbewole, SAN, the Vice Chancellor of the University of Ilorin, Nigeria, on Wednesday, 27 Dec. The two dignitaries discussed collaboration in the education sector.

The meeting explored the possibility for the University of Ilorin to join the D-8 Network of Pioneers for Research and Innovation (D-8 NPRI). The Vice-Chancellor also expressed his readiness to host the next meeting of the D-8 NPRI. The meeting also discussed the proposed student and staff exchange and joint research between University of Ilorin and other universities in the D8 Member States.

SECTORAL AND EXTERNAL RELATIONS ACTIVITIES

D-8 AND IOFS INKED JOINT ACTION PLAN ON AGRICULTURE AND FOOD SECURITY




Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam, the Secretary-General of the Developing-8 Organization for Economic Cooperation (D-8), attended the 2nd High-Level Forum on Food Security organized by the Islamic Organization for Food Security (IOFS) in cooperation with the Government of the State of Qatar in Doha on 1-3 October 2023. Mr. Punjul S. Nugraha, Director for Economy and External Relations of the Organization's Secretariat, accompanied the D-8 SG.

At the event, the D-8 and the IOFS signed a 'Joint Action Plan' to enhance collaboration in agriculture and food security, which took place on Sunday, 1 October 2023, on the margins of the 2nd High-Level Forum on Food Security of the IOFS.

Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam represented the D-8 Organization during the signing ceremony, while Dr. Masoud Al-Marri, Chairman of the Executive Board of IOFS, signed on behalf of the IOFS.

The Joint Action Plan is an implementation mechanism of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on Institutional Cooperation, signed between the two Organizations in Nouakchott, Mauritania on 17 March 2023. It covers 12 specific agricultural and food security programs, which will be implemented from 2024 -2026.



In his brief remarks during the signing ceremony, the D-8 SG noted that the MoU and the Joint Action Plan would provide a solid foundation for more robust and tangible collaboration between the D-8 and IOFS. He said that continuing collaboration was also required in order to address the challenges of deficiency in agricultural production and food security in D-8 member countries.

In addition to signing the Joint Action Plan, the D-8 SG also delivered an opening remark at the Sub-Forum on the Role of Civil Society Organizations in Agricultural Development and Food Security, as part of the 2nd High-Level Forum on Food Security, organized by the IOFS in Doha, Qatar, on 1 October 2023.

The IOFS is a specialized institution of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC), specifically tasked to enhance agriculture and food security sectors within the OIC. The IOFS organized the 2nd High-Level Forum on Food Security and the 6th Session of its General Assembly, back-to-back with the 9th OIC Ministerial Conference on Agriculture and Food Security from 1 – 3 October 2023.

The D-8 SG attended the IOFS and OIC events upon the invitation from the respective organizations.

D-8 ACTIVITIES AT THE UNCTAD'S 8TH WORLD INVESTMENT FORUM

On the invitation of H.E. Ms. Rebecca Grynspan, the Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD), Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam, the D-8 Secretary-General, participated at the 8th World Investment Forum (WIF) in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates from 16 – 23 October 2023. He was accompanied by the duo of Punjul S. Nugraha, Director for Economy and External Relations, and Md. Biplob Tarafder, Programme Officer of the D-8 Secretariat,

At the 8th WIF, the D-8 SG undertook the following activities:

D-8 AND UNCTAD JOINT CONFERENCE ON GUIDING PRINCIPLES FOR INVESTMENT





The D-8 and UNCTAD co-organized the Joint Conference on the Guiding Principles for Investment as part of the 8th WIF in Abu Dhabi on 16 October 2023.

Experts from the D-8 Member States provided updates on their respective countries' efforts to modernize and align their investment policies with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. One of the notable outcomes of the session was the agreement to institutionalize discussion on the modernization of the promotion of investments in the D-8 member states.

THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF IRENA



The D-8 SG held a bilateral meeting with H.E. Mr. Francesco La Camera, the Director-General of the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), on the margins of the 8th WIF in Abu Dhabi on 17 October 2023.

They discussed potential collaboration between the D-8 and IRENA in supporting renewable energy development and transition in the D-8 Member States.

D-8 SECRETARY-GENERAL SPOKE AT THE INVESTMENT MINISTERIAL ROUNDTABLE IN ABU DHABI



As part of his active participation in the 8th World Investment Forum, Ambassador Isiaka Imam, the D-8 Secretary-General, participated as a speaker in the Investment Ministerial Roundtable in Abu Dhabi on 20 October 2023. H.E. Manoa Seru Kamikamica, the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Trade, Cooperatives, Small and Medium Enterprises and Communications, the Republic of Fiji, and Ms. Rebecca Grynspann, the Secretary-General of UNCTAD, co-chaired the Roundtable.

The D-8 Secretary-General highlighted that international organizations and donors must extend their technical and financial support to improve the economy of developing countries' capacity to foster investment for sustainable development.

He also underlined that there must be flexibility in applying standards and measures for developing countries in investment. Trade discrimination against developing countries, in many of its facades, must be minimized. The same ideals apply to our fight against climate change and safeguarding biodiversity.

Furthermore, the D-8 Secretary-General also underscored the importance of ensuring every country's right to develop and grow. We must provide an equitable and inclusive global architecture to aid economic development.

He concluded with a call that efforts to reform the international investment agreements must take cognizance of the interests of the global south. This can be achieved by prioritizing the development of next-generation investment policies.

The D-8 SG presented an update on the activities of the D-8 organization to his counterpart, while Ambassador Rimi gave his views on how to strengthen collaboration in the D-8 key priority areas, particularly in agriculture, food security, trade, and investment.



THE D-8 SG MET WITH THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF WAIPA



These issues dominated the Virtual Workshop on "Climate Smart Agriculture Techniques and Projects, Sharing Experience by Türkiye", jointly organized by the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry of Türkiye and the D-8 Secretariat on 15 November 2023.

Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam, the D-8 Secretary-General, delivered opening remarks at the Workshop, followed by a lively and interactive discussion encompassing the need to strengthen agricultural cooperation within the D-8.

The Workshop, attended by representatives from all D-8 Member States, discussed developing innovative agricultural practices to tackle the threat of climate change. Experiences and success stories were exchanged among the participants, led by Türkiye. The workshop agreed to explore tangible activities, including a workshop on climate-smart agriculture in a physical format.

AMBASSADOR IMAM PAID A COURTESY CALL ON THE TRADE MINISTER OF TÜRKIYE

Speaking further, Ambassador Imam, while briefing his host, underscored the significance of early implementation of the D-8 PTA to the overall economic development of the alliance Group of Nations, more so when the vexed issue of the Dispute Settlement Mechanism of the D-8 PTA has been concluded, successfully.

In response to the evolving global trade landscape and the need for the D-8 Organization to keep up with the trends, both the D-8 SG and his host, Prof. Ömer Bolat, addressed the imperative of establishing a D-8 E-commerce platform and a Barter Trading System.

The Minister of Trade of Türkiye, Prof. Ömer Bolat, also commended Secretary General Imam for his visionary leadership and commitment to advancing the economic agenda of the D-8 Organization. He expressed the full support of his Ministry in the implementation of the various initiatives aimed at enhancing the economic cooperation of the D-8 member states.

Sequel to the decision of the 47th Session of the D8 Commission to include women's economic empowerment on the agenda of the D8, the D8 SG, Ambassador Isiaka Imam, paid a courtesy call on the Her Excellency Madame Mahinur Özdemir Göktaş, the Minister of Family and Social Services of Türkiye in Ankara on 16 November 2023. Mr. Punjul S. Nugraha, Director for Economy and External Relations, and Mr. M. Bilal Khan, Executive Assistant of the D-8 Secretariat, accompanied the D-8 SG to the meeting.

During the meeting, the D8 SG secured crucial support from the Turkish government to advance women's economic empowerment. The two dignitaries discussed the D-8's effort to mainstream women's economic empowerment in the D-8. Ambassador Imam told the Minister that women's empowerment was crucial in the D-8 member states since more than half of the population is women.



To materialize the D-8 collective agenda, Ambassador Imam also proposed the hosting of the first D-8 women's economic empowerment summit and exhibition in Türkiye in the second quarter of 2024.

Minister Göktaş welcomed the D-8 group's efforts to mainstream women's economic empowerment in the D-8's development agenda. Minister Göktaş also welcomed the initiative to host the D-8 Women Economic Empowerment Summit and Exhibition in 2024. The First D-8 Women Economic Empowerment Summit and Exhibition will attract government officials, business leaders, key stakeholders in women's organizations, and NGOs from across member states.

MEETING WITH THE IRANIAN AMBASSADOR TO TÜRKIYE

After the Ceremony, the D-8 SG toured the 2023 Halal Expo and the D-8 Member States' pavilions. He congratulated the D-8 delegations from the Member States for participating in the 2023 Halal Expo.

BOOSTING D-8 PRIVATE SECTOR'S ROLE IN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

I am honored and privileged to contribute to the Fourth Edition of the D-8 Newsletter for 2024 to further introduce the D-8 Chamber of Commerce and Industries (D-8). I am happy to inform you that the D8-CCI Business Forum and Expo 2022 was held in Dhaka in July 2022 to mark the silver jubilee of the Developing-8 Organization for Economic Cooperation, established around cooperation among prominent Muslim developing countries across South Asia, Southeast Asia, Europe, and Africa.

The D-8 Chamber of Commerce and Industries (D8-CCI) is the trade and investment affiliate of the D-8, comprising eight national chambers of commerce and collectively representing a five trillion-dollar economy.

The D8-CCI has worked on a strategic roadmap aimed at each of our strength sectors for PTA ratification and engagement in value chain integration across the agriculture, manufacturing, tertiary, and quaternary sectors. The modalities of cooperation we propose employ value chain integration in the long run, mitigating supply chain volatility with pegged price guarantees. This will assist in strengthening supply chain security for agriculture, manufacturing, tertiary, and quaternary sectors, ensuring secured livelihood, employment, and investment within the D-8 economies.

In addition, alternative trade finance and trade facilitation processes such as cross-currency swaps, barter, and blockchain are to be explored to address the D-8 nations' foreign currency reserve vulnerabilities. To address non-tariff barriers, unified standardization and harmonization of processes among D-8 nations are proposed.

Moreover, easing the D-8 visa regime for entrepreneurs may assist in greater connectivity within the D-8 private sectors, resulting in a direct contribution towards greater intra-D-8 trade and flow of investments. Subsequent moves towards mapping contingencies for the D-8 Comprehensive. Economic Cooperation Agreement (D8-CECA) will assist in the long-term D-8 value chain integration.

Furthermore, enabling technologies across economic sectors, we emphasize on Cybersecurity, 4IR, IOT, AI, Data Analytics, Industrial IOT, Components and Equipment as high priorities of value chain integration. Sustainability, circular economy, she-trades, MSMEs, start-up ecosystem, innovation, green technology, climate change and blue economy are also priority agendas for implementing value chain integration.

The need for an alternative mechanism for dispute resolution between member nations was also acknowledged. As arbitration serves to streamline, smoothen and ensure uninterrupted development of business, investment and trade, it is vital that an effective method for dispute resolution be identified and established. The general consensus was reached with a strong recommendation that the facilitation of alternative dispute resolution, done via the Islamic Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture (ICCIA) Center in Istanbul, be thoroughly examined and evaluated for consideration. Upon successful evaluation, the process may be adapted for disputes arising from the D-8 private sectors; the final decision for which can be decided in the next general assembly.

Additionally, the D-8 Chambers of Commerce and Industries decided and agreed to revisit the Antalya Joint Declaration, over and above the strategic roadmap. Due to developments beyond our macroeconomic policies, there are always new challenges to overcome in trade but the proposed work plan and strategic roadmap, shared around creating D8-CCI Value Chain Integration, can enable us to tackle these challenges with ease.

D-8 HSP COLLABORATES WITH GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE SECTORS TO DRIVE UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE IN NIGERIA



D-8 Health and Social Protection Programme (D8-HSP) has intensified its partnerships and collaboration with private sectors and government to accelerate Universal Health Coverage (UHC) in Nigeria and other D-8 Member Countries. This is in line with its mandate to advance healthcare, social protection and sustainable development in the D-8 member countries. In Nigeria, the D-8 HSP commenced a community project to support the development of Primary Health Care Centres to ensure improved access to health infrastructure and services.

Driven by the desire to achieve its objective to support the development of Primary Health Care Centres in communities in order to ensure improved access to health infrastructure and services, the D-8 HSP office in Nigeria recently collaborated with Honourable Mohammed Bello El-Rufai, a legislator representing Kaduna North Senatorial District, to build a ward for a hospital in Kaduna State. The D-8 HSP built 10-bed hospital ward was to support the ongoing infrastructural development of 225 Primary Health Care wards in Kaduna State aimed at accelerating UHC gains and improve access to healthcare services.

The goal of the D-8 HSP is to enhance the capacity of the healthcare facilities to provide critical medical services and address healthcare disparities in undeserved communities in Nigeria.

According to Dr Ado J. G. Muhammad, the Global Director of D-8 HSP, "The community healthcare development project of the D-8 HSP is a boost to existing community-driven initiatives across Nigeria. We aspire to support communities in member countries with health facilities equipped with state-of-the-art medical equipment and staffed by skilled and compassionate healthcare professionals, to ensure member countries are making progress to achieve Universal Health Coverage (UHC)."

D-8 HSP SUPPORTS NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR REFUGEES AND MIGRANTS TO IMPROVE SERVICES IN NIGERIA



In line with the mandate of the D-8 Health and Social Protection Programme to support the health and social protection projects across member countries, the D-8 HSP office in Nigeria, has provided technical assistance to Nigeria's National Commission for Refugees, Migrants and Internally Displaced Persons (NCFRM) to address the gaps in the protection of vulnerable populations, including refugees, migrants and internally displaced persons in Nigeria.

As part of the support to the NCFRM, D-8 HSP also provided a desk officer to strengthen the Commission's capacity to deliver critical services to refugees, migrants and IDPs and to improve access to essential healthcare, education, shelter and livelihood opportunities.

Following the request of the Commission, the D-8 HSP desk officer provided expertise to support the development and implementation of policies and programs that addresses the specific needs of displaced populations. These encompassed initiatives related to legal protection, social integration, and economic empowerment.

Speaking on the support of D-8 HSP to NCFRM, the Global Director of D-8 HSP, Dr. Ado J.G. Muhammad harped on effective coordination among government agencies, non-governmental organizations, (NGOs) and international partners as essential ingredients for responding to displacement crises. He assured that the D-8 HSP will continue to support coordination efforts aimed at fostering collaboration among stakeholders.
